LOLA'S STORY

PART 1

Lola (now called Dilly) came to AFC in 2016. She had a medical condition called rectal-vaginal fistula and anal atresia...in other words she was born without a rectum. She eliminated through her vagina for both her duties. She had lived this way all her life, about 20 months.

We knew this little girl was just as special as many other dogs and decided to do whatever it would take to get her well and ready for a forever home. Lola was a happy girl and enjoyed dancing, she loved to get us to tap dance so that she could dance around and play with our shoes, lol.



The cost of her surgery would be \$4,200. To pay for her surgery AFC applied and received a \$1,000 grant from UC Davis; then fundraised for the remainder. The surgery was a success. At least 4 potential adopters made appointments over the years but never even showed up to meet this special girl. Lola was loved and lived a happy life with us at AFCHS.

PART 2

Early January 2021, AFCHS received an application for Lola. The potential adopter stated that she had a beautiful and safe home for Lola to thrive in happily. That she has a network of dog-owning neighbors for Lola to socialize, exercise, and play with. She also had decades of experience with dogs who are shut-down, over-reactive, ill, abused, under-socialized, traumatized, and who have never had good experiences with people or who have never lived in a home. She had a lot to offer Lola. A meet and greet was arranged.

She would have to travel nearly 6 hours round trip so if the meet and greet was successful she would expect to take Lola home that day.

After a thorough and thoughtful interview process, Lola was officially adopted out to this wonderful applicant. The day of the adoption came, and the meeting was a success. Lola had a wonderful trip to her new home. Her new mommy stated that Lola slept most of the way with only one pitstop for potty and a drink.



PART 3

Lola's new mommy, Cathie, emailed us wonderful updates on Lola's adjustment to her new home. Her updates confirmed we had made the right decision in placing Lola with her. One of the updates that stood out to us the most was Lola now had a new name.

Cathie just didn't like her name of "Lola". Cathie named all her dogs according to their personalities. Lola's big brown eyes filled with a twinkle, reminded her of a little girl she had met many years ago who had those same big brown eyes filled with a twinkle, so after careful thought and consideration, she would name her "Dilly". She hoped that AFCHS would understand the name change, and of course they did.

PART 4

After a few months of adjusting in her new home, Dilly and her mom took a trip back to visit us at AFC. Her mommy shared with us the health issues she discovered after taking Dilly to her vet. These were issues AFC was never aware of; even though she went to the vet every so often it was missed. Once again this wonderful angel's reaction to Dilly (Lola) was a confirmation that we placed her in the perfect home. Dilly's health issues were being addressed and it was evident that her mommy was caring for her well.

Here is a picture of our AFC staff/volunteers with our sweet Lola aka Dilly. This made all of us cry with happiness as she was loved very much by all of us at AFC. We loved seeing her so happy.

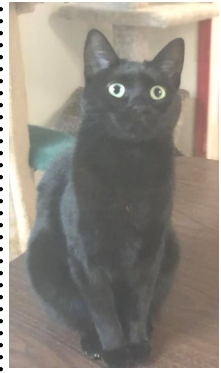

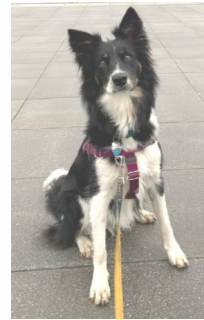

| Dog food - Canidae "All Stages" | Collars that are for small Dogs (size's 7-11 and 11-14) we have plenty of large dog collars |
| Dry dog food, Kirkland Chicken & Rice dry dog food (red bag) | Blow dryer to dry dogs after bathing |
| Kirkland rom Costco Natures Domain canned dog food | Postage stamps |
| Cat Food - Felidae dry cat food | Break-away cat collars (or stretch kitten collars) |
| Kirkland dry cat food, Natural Balance or Blue Buffalo or Nutro for the Cats | COT style cat and dog beds, or gently used beds and cots |
| Friskies canned cat food and other higher quality canned cat foods | Smaller twin-size blankets for the dogs that sleep inside |
| Treats for Cats and Dogs (please made in the USA only) – Nutro Greenies are also a good treat for cats (not for dogs) | Small blankets for the cat beds (baby blankets work well) |
| Cat litter – "Litter Perfect" from Costco, or other high quality litter | A handy-person willing to donate time. We need repairs inside and outside, as well as electrical work |

| Laundry detergent, Pine-sol - mops, brooms- squeegee | Van to transport our dogs and cats |
| Paper towels and toilet paper | Land or a house with a little property, located (if possible) in Lodi or between Stockton and Lodi for a permanent adoption center/ shelter. We have outgrown our location. *** |
| Toys for Cats and Dogs (toy's that have a squeaker in them for the Dogs but no stuffing) | |
| Four foot leashes for the Dogs | |

We send our adopted dogs home with smaller blankets that they have slept on for a night or two. People tell us that the dog uses it as their comfort blanket forever, so we are happy to have sent one along. They can sometimes be purchased at places like Walgreens, CVS pharmacy, Target, etc. They can also be made by purchasing fabric, cut in strands at the edges then tied, making a nice double blanket. Girl Scouts and other individuals have made these for us. Please call and we can tell you the size. For more ideas call (209) 365-0535. Cash donations are always needed and appreciated so we can purchase other necessary items.
