If you're thinking of making a fuss of your pets with some extra food treats this Christmas here are some safe foods. Small amount of White Turkey, Pumpkin, Green beans, Peas, Carrots, Apples (never the core or seeds), Spinach, Winter squash, Melon, Berries, Bananas Some festive plants and flowers can be toxic to pets, including poinsettias, holly, ivy, mistletoe and lilies, so avoid buying these if you have pets. Tinsel and wrapping paper might be tempting for your pet to play with, but make sure they don't eat it! Christmas trees and pets: It's best to only allow your pets around the tree when you can keep a close eye on them, because the decorations are not safe for them to play with or eat. The water is also toxic.

Christmas can be busy and chaotic, but you can help your pet cope with the chaos by sticking to their normal routine as much as possible. That way your pets and you can enjoy the Holliday Season!

All it takes is a few hours of spare time once a week to make a difference to the animals. Sanctuary News

It's been a long hectic year - Grumble—Grumble

The owner of our property still wants us to move; however we have been unable to find a property locally that we can afford. They have increased our rent over $4\frac{1}{2}$ times the amount we used to pay . Needless to say this has been a hardship on us. The City of Lodi used to give non-profits a very nice discount on their electric bill, but that has also been taken away from us and the bill has increased three fold. Please bear with us as we continue...LOL We need to take all of this with a grain of humor.

Donations still have not gone back to where they were before COVID. Facebook put new regulations on raising money via PAYPAL, This has prevented us from raising money on Facebook.; to help with the on-going emergencies that arise We have been working for the past year on trying to figure out what they want us to do. We understand that other non-profits are also having difficulty with trying to figure out what they want. With all of that, donations are down by at least \$30,000. The owner of Jeremy wine Company (Jeremy) is helping us try to get it back up. He was able to create a link that we can add to our Facebook posts that will take a donor straight to Pay-Pal to make a donation. We are forever grateful.

We've had air conditioning problems this year and were able to barely make it out of the hot weather with it working on again off again. It is too difficult for the animals and the staff when we have weather in the 90's and above. We will have to replace the air conditioner next spring, which is around \$13,000 to \$15,000.

We are not able to fundraise as much as we used to since we are down from three major fundraisers to two.

We have had so many kittens, cats, puppies and dogs dumped at our door step. Many are injured kittens, cats and dogs (with injuries too terrible to describe). We make it our mission to provide the medical care that they need. The cost of spays and neuters for both cats and dogs have more than tripled this year and our adoption fees do not cover them. At this time we still have about 50 kittens that need loving families. In addition to that, we are the only shelter open 7 days a week in our area. Thank you to our Wonderful Staff!

In mid-November we had 8 beautiful puppy and dog adoptions all in one day. We had 6 cat/kittens adopted in one weekend also. Fortunately we have also gotten quite a few of our young adult cats out this year and we are working on getting the kittens adopted too. We are overwhelmed with gratitude for all these adoptions.

It takes a lot of time to interview and send people the adoption information, but the joy in creating new loving families is worth it... Our success stories are beautiful and it is so worth our energy, time and money. The staff, volunteers and board members all love what we do even though it is exhausting.

With all of this joy to spread.

Also, these wishes can improve or expand our organization to be able to help more homeless animals. Below is a list of our current wishes:

Dog food - Canidae "All Stages"
